

Graduate Junior Consultant

Role

This position is aimed at graduates or individuals who have graduated within the last 2 years. You will be working as a junior consultant in client projects learning the various stages of a project's lifecycle including requirements gathering, design, build, deployment and support.

Technologies used will vary by client and project but expect to be learning and using technologies within the Microsoft Business Intelligence stack, SQL Server 2005/2008, Reporting Services, Integration Services, and Analysis Services. Some projects will involve the .NET framework stack, such as C#, VB.NET, ASP.NET, LINQ, HTML, XML, WPF, WCF and Silverlight.

As well as working on projects, Junior Consultants are actively encouraged to study toward suitable technical certifications, such as becoming Microsoft Certified Technology Specialist certified (MCTS). In addition, all junior consultants are assigned a mentor who will both appraise your performance and provide career guidance.

Our UK office is based in Godalming, Surrey. However, expect that the majority of your time will be spent on client site. Although many clients are based in South East England, applicants must be willing to travel and spend some time away from home.

Graduate recruitment is all year round. Typically, graduates join us between June and September; however, the start date is negotiable.

As well as a competitive salary, junior consultants are also eligible for personal and company performance related bonuses. Other benefits include training and medical cover. Those who excel in the role are likely to be quickly promoted to consultant with improved remuneration and a car allowance.

Required skills

Technical

A suitable candidate should:

- Be studying/studied for a relevant degree in IT, the sciences or engineering
- Proficient in Excel, Word and PowerPoint
- To be numerate and have a logical mind
- Some previous academic or industrial experience in web development
- Some previous academic or industrial experience in designing and querying databases (SQL)
- Candidates need to be fluent in written and spoken English
- Valid driving licence and car

Although not required, candidates who have data warehouse experience and/or experience with multidimensional databases is advantageous.
